Volunteer Covid Induction

In order to protect all our volunteer's health each volunteer must read and agree to follow and comply with the following measures outlined in this induction form. This form must be signed and returned to the Society at the following email address info@ssexplorer.org prior to travelling to the ship for the first time.

Volunteer Section

I am free of the following symptoms

High temperature New continuous cough Loss/change in sense of smell/taste

I have not been advised to shield by my GP

I am not in the moderate risk category which includes people who

- Have a chronic lung, or kidney condition
- Have heart or liver disease
- Have diabetes
- Have a neurological condition
- Have a poor immune system
- Are taking medicine that can affect the immune system such as steroids
- Have a BMI of 40 or higher
- Are pregnant.

Consent to a temperature check before on the gangway,

If you have temperature of 38 deg you will be asked to return home.

Agree to maintain social distancing as advised by the risk assessment

I will bring my own pen and cup each time I visit if possible.

I will sanitise my hands every time I enter & leave rooms and periodically

Discuss the work with others to make sure it can be done following the control measures

When using tools I will not share with others, wipe tools with disinfectant wipes before and after use.

I agree to follow the control measures in place.

I will read the covid 19 information posters onboard.

If you do suffer symptoms within 14 days of visiting the ship should inform a director immediately.

Company Section

The Society will arrange for

- A sufficient supply of hand sanitiser at required locations around the vessel
- A sufficient supply of disinfectant wipes at required locations around the vessel
- Regular cleaning of all touch points to be carried out
- Record dates and names of volunteers onboard.

The society, if advised that a volunteer has been infected and has been onboard in the previous 14 days, will notify all other volunteers who have been onboard during those 14 days. The person's name will remain confidential and will not be recorded.

If a point of infection is traced back to the vessel the society will follow the Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 2013 and inform the Health and Safety Executive through the required reporting guidance and procedures.

The Society has a right to refuse entry to the vessel to anyone who

- Has not provided a signed induction form in advance
- Shows an elevated temperature prior to boarding 3 times within a 15 minute interval
- Shows symptoms while onboard
- Fails to comply with the control measures set out.
